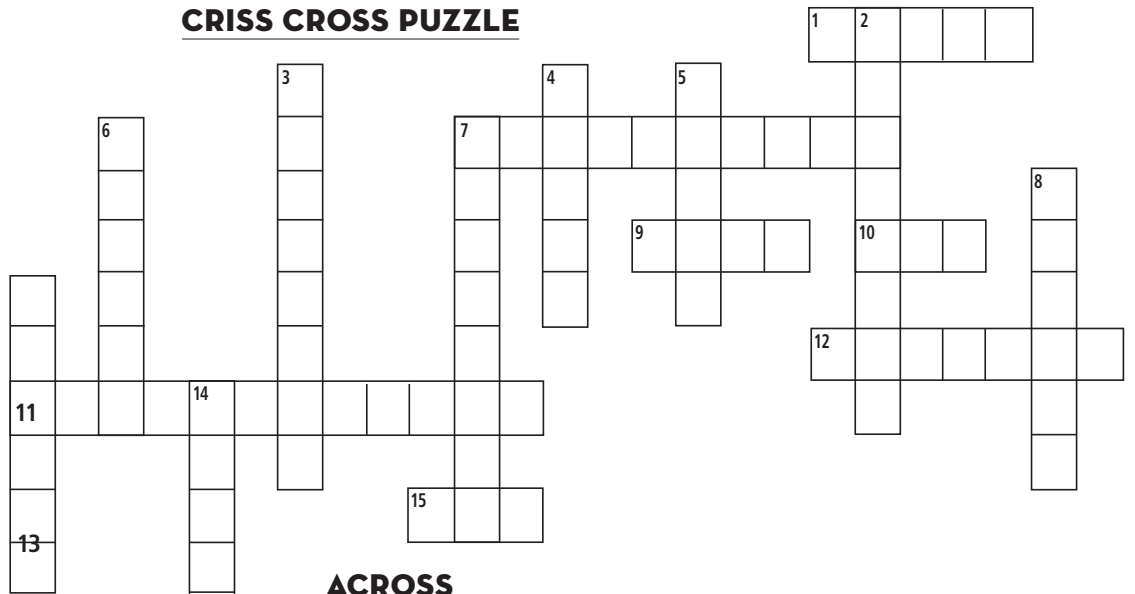

- Year (in Roman numerals) St. Eugene became pope.
- A trial of skill in some games in which competitors play a series of contests.
- Roman Catholic organization established first in 1882.
- Along with "St.," this word is the start of many Catholic churches' names.
- This is a collective community in Israel first established in 1909.
- This Brazilian city hosts one of the world's most famous carnivals.
- The name of 13 different popes.

DOWN

- This word, when lowercase, means "universal."
- This word can be traced to the Latin "festa" meaning "a religious holiday."
- This slang term for "delicious" derives from the sound of smacking the lips and describes a lot of food found at carnivals.
- St. John Paul II's real first name.
- St. John XXIII's real first name.
- A service held during Holy Week.
- The pastoral care of a parish is entrusted to this person under the authority of the diocesan bishop.
- This word, which comes from the Latin *parochus*, is a stable community of the faithful within a particular Catholic Church.
- One treat found at many carnivals and festivals is named after this pachyderm's ear.
