ANNUAL DEACON ASSESSMENTS: Annual Assessment invoices were sent the last week of June. 46% of the Assessments have been collected to date.

This is the question that typically follows, "What if my parish doesn't pay the assessment?"

- Step One: We will send out a 30-day reminder via email. This email goes to the business manager, Pastor and the deacon. Your relationship with parish helps the process.
- Step Two: We will send out a 60-day reminder via Official Mail.

NOTES:

- 1. Parishes are sending the invoices back noting inactivity of specific deacons. This office will be notifying all deacons via letter of a status change to "inactive" at the end of the 90-day collections time frame.
- 2. Should assessments not be paid for any deacon desiring to participate in the Convocation or Diocese sponsored retreats & continuing formation, the deacon will be invoiced directly and payment must be received prior to the scheduled event.

It is in your best interest to encourage your parish to fund your annual Deacon Assessment as it can affect your good standing as a deacon.

- 1. Updating several email and home addresses
- 2. Identifying "seasonal" deacons (impacts Parish Deacon Assessments)
- 3. A high percentage of participants claim to have an excellent relationship with their pastor.
- 4. A high percentage of participants, while happy with their current assignment are at least somewhat open to reassignments.





ADMINISTRATIVE

Deacon Annual Documents

Effective July 1, 2018 Deacons who have not submitted their annual documents will **NOT** be considered to be in "Good Standing".

Summary of Deacons in Good Standing:

As of July 25, 2018:

- Of the 196 "Active & Senior" deacons' active in ministry 44% have turned in their Statement of Mutual Expectation/Assessment and Continuing Formation records.
- Of the 231 deacons living in the Diocese, including "inactive" deacons 40% have their funeral arrangements on file with the diocese.

All the forms are on the **Deacon Webpage** in English & Spanish. They are regularly updated as we work to ensure clarity in what is required.

NOTE: Those completing the forms in Spanish must have them translated to English prior to submitting to the Office of the Permanent Diaconate.



Disaster Services

Disaster Services continues to evolve. Eighteen parishes are officially committed to serving as emergency food and water distribution sites as needed following a tragedy. Site operation manuals, signs, vests and gloves are now being distributed to the site coordinators. The eighteen parishes include: Our Lady of Grace, Palm Bay; Church of Our Savior, Cocoa Beach; Blessed Sacrament, Clermont; St. Timothy, Lady Lake; St. Lawrence, Bushnell; Prince of Peace, Ormond Beach; Our Lady of the Lakes, Deltona; St. John the Baptist, Dunnellon; Blessed Trinity, Ocala; St. Theresa, Belleview; St. Francis of Assisi, Apopka; St. Joseph/St. Maximilian Kolbe, Orlando; St. Catherine of Siena, Kissimmee; St. Rose of Lima, Poinciana; Holy Spirit, Lake Wales; St. Joseph, Lakeland; St. Stephen, Winter Springs; and, All Souls, Sanford. In addition, the main campus of Catholic Charities of Central Florida will also serve as a distribution site. Mental First Aid Training

Catholic Charities is able to provide "Mental Health First Aid" Training to interested parishes/communities. This is a nationally recognized, evidence-based program aimed at helping us to better understand adults who may be experiencing mental health concerns, training us on how to respond to them with compassion and sensitivity and increasing awareness of the many facets of mental illness. Many of our parishes engage in outreach ministries to the homeless and the poor and mental health concerns are often evident. This class better equips us to respond with love and compassion. Classes can accommodate up to 30 individuals. The training takes 8 hours and can be done in one day or in two four-hour sessions.  - o Prepare and submit the monthly mentor report, and
 - Prepare and submit the annual recommendation for continued formation & ordination.
